



## **Anson Registrars wins two high profile appointments**

Anson Registrars Limited, Guernsey's only locally-owned CREST registrar, has recently won two high profile share registrar appointments.

Chariot Oil & Gas Limited is an independent oil and gas exploration group, focused on the exploration of the South Atlantic margins, specifically Namibia. Its shares were admitted to trading on AIM in May via a placing which raised gross proceeds of £45.0 million. The group owns a portfolio of oil and gas exploration licences in Namibia, covering ten blocks, eight of which are offshore and two of which are onshore. The company is administered by Artemis Trustees Limited.

CEIBA Investments Limited is listed on the Channel Islands Stock Exchange and currently is the only listed fund investing purely in Cuba. The fund is one of the few conduits through which foreign exchange can be channelled into Cuba, principally for the tourism industry. The company has a controlling interest in Havana's leading office and commercial real estate complex. The company is administered by Bachmann Fund Administration Limited.

Commenting on the new appointments, Managing Director of Anson Registrars, Christopher Crowcroft noted: "We are delighted to be able to work with two of Guernsey's premier fund administrators and to provide CREST share registration services to Chariot and CEIBA and their shareholders."
